Basic Guidelines

- Unless otherwise specified, all clothing items must come from Parker Uniforms.
- **Outerwear** (coats and jackets)
 (2007-08) Outerwear may come from any vendor, but outerwear worn into the classroom may not have large writing or artwork. Any Parker outerwear and most school-sold spirit outerwear (including letter jackets) may also be worn into a classroom. Sweatshirts and hooded sweatshirts are not permitted.
 (2008-09) Outerwear may come from any vendor, but all outerwear worn into the classroom must come either from Parker or from the school store (including letter jackets). Sweatshirts and hooded sweatshirts are not permitted.
- **Shoes** may come from any vendor. Shoes for both boys and girls must be low quarter and low heel, closed toe, and closed heel. Shoes must be brown, tan, or black leather or suede; or athletic shoes in solid white, black, or gray. Any shoe offered by Parker is acceptable. Shoe strings must be in a color that matches the shoe.
- **Khaki pants** (not capris) may be purchased from any vendor but must be similar in color and style to the traditional khaki pants offered by Parker, with pleated or plain front. No cargo pants are allowed. Suggested vendors include Gap (uniform line); Lands End (uniform line); Sears and Target (French Toast brand).
- **Belts** (solid black or brown) may be purchased from any vendor and must be worn by boys.
- **Socks, tights, leggings**
 Socks are required for boys and must be visible. Visible socks or tights are required for girls. White crew/bobby socks and ankle socks may come from any vendor. Girls' knee socks, tights, and leggings must come from Parker. Socks must be worn with leggings. Girls' ankle socks may be worn with capris only.
- Boys' shirts must be tucked in.
- Girls' skirts must be no more than two inches (2") from the floor when the student is kneeling on the floor.
- Girls are encouraged to wear a plain white undershirt or camisole (no lace or trim) under their blouses. No garment may show from the bottom of the blouse. No underwear may show. Boys must wear plain white undershirts with oxford shirts.
- Hats, hoods, and caps may not be worn indoors.
- Hair must be clean and neat and not extreme in style. Unnatural hair coloring is not permitted.
- Boys' hair (including braids) must not be longer than the eyebrows, top of the collar, or middle of the ear. Long sideburns are not permitted.
- Boys must be clean shaven daily.
- Boys may not wear earrings.
- Visible tattoos, real or fake, are not permitted.
- Body piercing is not permitted, other than girls' ears (maximum of two earrings per ear).
- Writing or drawing on the skin is not permitted.
- Students are not required to wear uniforms at extracurricular activities unless uniforms are specified; but for any school related event, on or off campus, clothing must always be appropriate for Christian young people.
- There will be special occasions when students will be permitted to wear clothing other than uniforms. On these occasions (Spirit Days, for example), clothing will be expected to be modest, neat, clean, appropriately-fitting, in good repair, and in keeping with the principles of a Christian school. Specific guidelines will be given for the special days.
- Students may be asked to wear the required uniform for field trips or special events.
