Participants: Sports and LEAP camps are open to the community unless otherwise indicated. Day Camp is a service provided for Harding families. EC1 students must be 18 months of age by June 1.

Registration: NEW! Online registration powered by Active.com will be available mid-March. NEW! Payments may be made by MasterCard, Visa, Discover, and eChecks. Forms may still be downloaded and printed but we ask that you go to www.hardinglions.org/summer to register and pay. This will help us maintain the most accurate records. Forms and fees may be taken to a Harding location or mailed to:

Fees: All fees must be paid at the time of registration. Fees are not refundable after the first day of camp. Fees will not be adjusted if you are unable to attend all camp days.

Confirmations: No confirmations will be issued. Students will be contacted ONLY if the camp is FULL or in the event of cancellation.

Cancellations: Camps with insufficient enrollment are subject to cancellation with a full refund. Notification of cancellation will be made prior to the beginning of the camp.

Discontinuation: Students are expected to adhere to the policies of Harding Academy. We reserve the right to dismiss from the program (without refund) any student whose behavior becomes uncooperative.

Attendance: No refunds will be given for students who choose not to attend camp.

After-camp Care: Harding Academy families (only) are eligible for Before/After-care through Harding Summer Day Camp. Before-care is complimentary. After-care fees apply.

General Policies: Do not leave a child unsupervised on campus. All students and athletes must be picked up PROMPTLY after camp or LATE FEES MAY APPLY. No childcare will be provided. Students are to be neatly dressed in modest apparel. 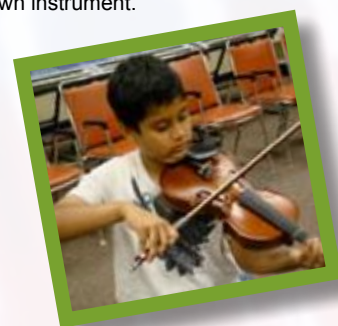
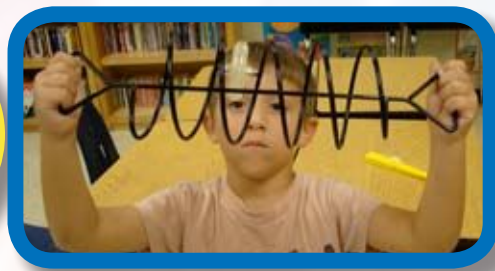
